- 1. Romans 12:10**
Be devoted to **one another** in love. Honour **one another** above yourselves.
- 2. Romans 12:16**
Live in harmony with **one another**. Do not be proud, but be willing to associate with people of low position. Do not be conceited.
- 3. Romans 13:8**
Let no debt remain outstanding, except the continuing debt to love **one another**, for whoever loves others has fulfilled the law.
- 4. Romans 14:13**
Therefore let us stop passing judgment on **one another**. Instead, make up your mind not to put any stumbling block or obstacle in the way of a brother or sister.
- 5. Romans 15:7**
Accept **one another**, then, just as Christ accepted you, in order to bring praise to God.
- 6. Romans 15:14**
I myself am convinced, my brothers and sisters, that you yourselves are full of goodness, filled with knowledge and competent to instruct **one another**.
- 7. Romans 16:16**
Greet **one another** with a holy kiss. All the churches of Christ send greetings.
- 8. 1 Corinthians 1:10**
I appeal to you, brothers and sisters, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree with **one another** in what you say and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly united in mind and thought.
- 9. 1 Corinthians 16:20**
All the brothers and sisters here send you greetings. Greet **one another** with a holy kiss.
- 10. 2 Corinthians 13:11**
Finally, brothers and sisters, rejoice! Strive for full restoration, encourage **one another**, be of one mind, live in peace. And the God of love and peace will be with you.
- 11. 2 Corinthians 13:12**
Greet **one another** with a holy kiss.
- 12. Galatians 5:13**
You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the flesh; rather, serve **one another** humbly in love.

13. Ephesians 4:2

Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with **one another** in love.

14. Ephesians 4:32

Be kind and compassionate to **one another**, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.

15. Ephesians 5:19

speaking to **one another** with psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit. Sing and make music from your heart to the Lord,

16. Ephesians 5:21

Submit to **one another** out of reverence for Christ.

17. Philippians 2:5

In your relationships with **one another**, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus:

18. Colossians 3:13

Bear with each other and forgive **one another** if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you.

19. Colossians 3:16

Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish **one another** with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts.

20. 1 Thessalonians 4:9

Now about your love for **one another** we do not need to write to you, for you yourselves have been taught by God to love each other.

21. 1 Thessalonians 4:18

Therefore encourage **one another** with these words.

22. 1 Thessalonians 5:11

Therefore encourage **one another** and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing.

23. 2 Thessalonians 1:3

We ought always to thank God for you, brothers and sisters, and rightly so, because your faith is growing more and more, and the love all of you have for **one another** is increasing.

24. **Hebrews 3:13**

But encourage **one another** daily, as long as it is called “Today,” so that none of you may be hardened by sin’s deceitfulness.

25. **Hebrews 10:24**

And let us consider how we may spur **one another** on toward love and good deeds,

26. **Hebrews 10:25**

not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging **one another**—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.

27. **Hebrews 13:1**

Keep on loving **one another** as brothers and sisters.

28. **James 4:11**

Brothers and sisters, do not slander **one another**. Anyone who speaks against a brother or sister or judges them speaks against the law and judges it. When you judge the law, you are not keeping it, but sitting in judgment on it.

29. **James 5:9**

Don’t grumble against **one another**, brothers and sisters, or you will be judged. The Judge is standing at the door!

30. **1 Peter 1:22**

Now that you have purified yourselves by obeying the truth so that you have sincere love for each other, love **one another** deeply, from the heart.

31. **1 Peter 3:8**

Finally, all of you, be like-minded, be sympathetic, love **one another**, be compassionate and humble.

32. **1 Peter 4:9**

Offer hospitality to **one another** without grumbling.

33. **1 Peter 5:5**

In the same way, you who are younger, submit yourselves to your elders. All of you, clothe yourselves with humility toward **one another**, because, “God opposes the proud but shows favour to the humble.”

34. **1 Peter 5:14**

Greet **one another** with a kiss of love. Peace to all of you who are in Christ.

35. **1 John 1:7**

But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with **one another**, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin.

36. **1 John 3:11**

For this is the message you heard from the beginning: We should love **one another**.

37. **1 John 3:23**

And this is his command: to believe in the name of his Son, Jesus Christ, and to love **one another** as he commanded us.

38. **1 John 4:7**

Dear friends, let us love **one another**, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God.

39. **1 John 4:11**

Dear friends, since God so loved us, we also ought to love **one another**.

40. **1 John 4:12**

No one has ever seen God; but if we love **one another**, God lives in us and his love is made complete in us.

41. **2 John 1:5**

And now, dear lady, I am not writing you a new command but one we have had from the beginning. I ask that we love **one another**.
