This is a Full-time (38 hours per week) position. The successful candidate will be both a strategic leader and a hands-on problem solver, leading volunteer and staff teams to create excellent, distraction-free worship services and event experiences across our campuses that support the mission and vision of the church.

Key Responsibilities and Duties:

- Technical & Production Leadership: Oversee all technical operations (audio, video, lighting AVL) for weekend services, special events, and online broadcasts across multiple campuses.
- Event Production Management: Serve as Production Manager for major church events (e.g., Christmas, Easter, Conferences), leading pre-production planning, budgeting, and technical rehearsals.
