God is doing a "new thing" in **Kagoshima, Japan**, through our missionary **Kevin** as 2026 brings remarkable growth and new opportunities for the Gospel. The Young Adults ministry at Hope Christ Church has expanded to eight regular members, supported by visitors at "Gospel Nights" and "Connect Group" events, with the goal of transitioning into a missional team that actively reaches out to the community.

Beyond the church, Kevin is building new relationships at Kagoshima University with English instructors and students, while also taking on a larger role within the local church leadership team to further support the ministry's expansion. As Kevin transitions into a full-time missionary role with a newly approved one-year visa, there are many opportunities for us to partner with the Lord to support him.
