Background

Faith Community Church (FCC) is an intentional disciple-making church, committed to growing authentic disciple-makers who love God passionately and love people practically. Our vision is to see people saved, churches revived and nations transformed for God's glory.

About the role

We are seeking an experienced **Pastor/Director** to lead our Tertiary Students Ministry (also known as "Vibe") on a **Full-time or Part-time (15.2-38 hours per week)** basis. The successful candidate will join our growing pastoral staff team based in Willetton, Perth. The aim of the Vibe Ministry is to shepherd and disciple Tertiary Students in Christ and reach Tertiary Students for Christ through pastoral leadership, leadership development, and modelling discipleship. The Vibe Pastor/Director will develop structures, strategies and programmes for discipleship and ensure Vibe Services and Connect Groups offer a home for tertiary students to experience God and community.

Key Responsibilities and Duties:

- Lead the Tertiary Ministry (Vibe) in alignment with FCC's mission, vision and seasonal focus.
- Provide pastoral leadership, care and discipleship to leaders and tertiary students.
- Identify, recruit, train, develop and deploy volunteers into leadership roles.
- Oversee and plan Vibe Services, Connect Groups, camps, retreats and other programmes to disciple and reach tertiary students.
- Collaborate with other ministries to holistically disciple tertiary students, including working with Kinetic Youth (Year 12 transition) and Impact (young working adults' transition).
- Engage leaders and mature believers from other ministries/generations to mentor Vibe leaders.
- Develop inter-church ministry relationships and support other organisations as opportunities arise.

Selection Criteria:

- Be a committed disciple of Jesus Christ.
- Aligns with the vision, mission and values of FCC.
- Carries a deep passion for nurturing and discipling the spiritual lives of tertiary students.
- Significant experience in leading, caring for and pastoring people.
- Tertiary education in Theology or Christian Ministry (Desirable).
- Demonstrated ability to lead, envision, grow and sustain volunteer teams.
- Demonstrated ability to relate well intergenerationally and work collaboratively in a team.
- Ability to work independently and effectively in a fast, fluid and flexible environment.
- Be a self-starter and team builder who thrives in a multigenerational and multi-department staff team.
