Updates from Indonesia



From April 8–15, 2026, a mission team from FCC set off for Indonesia, to equip local house church leaders, support village outreaches, and engage with various unique cultural and spiritual domains of the mission field. The week kicked off with meeting different field workers across the island to facilitate various workshops and seminars.



The group took some time to ask God for clues of people He would want them to meet. One of the local team members got an image of a young man sitting under a tree in doubt. They then went out and encountered such a man who was contemplating his own faith in God, seeking community. The home church was then able to help him make those connections. This all came through simple obedience.



The mission extended deep into remote regions, beginning with a children's outreach at a remote village where the team hosted games and distributed clothing and care packs to 65 children despite intense travel difficulties. The journey also culminated in a miraculous breakthrough, visiting a highly insular, unreached indigenous community, which is rooted in various occult traditions. We praise God for the incredible unity of our team, the love gifts provided by FCC connect groups, and the lasting relationships forged with our brothers and sisters from Indonesia!

Updates from Fukuoka



The missionary team in Fukuoka, Japan, experienced a highly fruitful season of outreach, beginning with a vibrant Christmas outreach party that brought together 17 attendees and featured an unexpected, encouraging response from a local university professor exploring the Gospel. The team had the opportunity to pray over people from different walks of life – from a student seeking peace to a grandfather seeking healing.



The team also partnered with a local network church for monthly "Noke English teaching" classes and helped run an Easter Sunday service where they led activities for up to 20 children with an overall event attendance of 67 people.

In addition to Joanna, the local missionary in Fukuoka stepped into a leadership role for the local church's older kids' Sunday school. Exciting new doors opened for the ministry, including the May launch of a monthly Mother & Kids Fellowship. Looking ahead, the team is actively preparing to host an upcoming short-term outreach team from FCC this July. Let's continue to celebrate wins that has occurred and to continue to lift up our brothers and sisters in Fukuoka into God's hands!

Prayer Requests from Kagoshima



In Kagoshima, the missionary team experienced a highly active and encouraging season of outreach, discipleship, and community building. A major highlight for the community occurred on March 20, when the church celebrated its first beach baptism in six to seven years, which was directly preceded by a meaningful Young Adults Fellowship Dinner to connect the next generation.

The team also focused heavily on relational evangelism and youth outreach, hosting a local after-school English Easter program for 12 children, assisting at a regional Christian spring camp for over 40 high schoolers, and conducting English lessons where they were able to share the Gospel with local teachers. An outdoor Easter Sunday service was also facilitated, which welcomed several interested pre-believers to hear the Gospel!

- Katalyst – Alpha Leadership Event (July 16–18)
 - Pray for emerging Christian leaders to be identified, inspired, activated, and sent out with a strong passion for the Gospel.
- Faith, Here and Now! – Kagoshima Worship & Outreach Event (July 18–19)
 - In collaboration with Hope Christ Church and featuring Takafumi Nagasawa. Pray that this event would encourage believers in Kagoshima, foster collaboration across Kyushu, and draw pre-believers to encounter Christ.
- Short-Term Mission Team from Faith Community Church (July 26 – August 3)
 - Partnering with Living Sanctuary Brethren Church and Miyazaki Christian Community. Pray for unity, effective ministry, and lasting impact among those they serve.
