### Background

### About the role

We are seeking an experienced Pastor to lead our Young Working Adults Ministry (also known as "Impact Ministry") on a full-time basis. The successful candidate will join our growing pastoral staff team based in Willetton, Perth. The aim of the Impact Ministry is to see every young working adult connected to Christ and released to change their world through intentional discipleship. The Impact Pastor will helm the Impact leadership team and ensure that Impact Service nights and Connect Groups offer a home for young working adults to experience God and community.

### Key Responsibilities and Duties:

- Lead the Impact Ministry in alignment with FCC's mission, vision and seasonal focus
- Provide pastoral leadership, care and discipleship to leaders and young working adults
- Recruit, raise, train, develop and retain volunteers and leaders
- Spearhead and oversee the execution of Impact Connect Groups, services, and other programmes
- Collaborate with other ministries to holistically disciple young working adults
- Serve as a key liaison person for Impact Ministry to other ministries and external parties
- Strengthen the partnerships between Impact Ministry and external marketplace ministries and missions organisations

- Be a committed disciple of Jesus Christ
- Aligns with the vision, mission and values of FCC
- Carries a deep passion for God and young working adults
- Has a theological degree or extensive ministry experience, including at least 3 years in leading young adults ministry
- 3 years of working experience in the marketplace
- Proven ability to preach, teach, and develop leaders
- Demonstrated ability to relate well cross-culturally and intergenerationally
- Maintains a flexible approach to changing priorities and duties
- Be a self-starter and team builder. Thrives in a team environment and works well in a multigenerational and multi-department staff team
