Background

About the role

We are seeking a Pastor to lead our children ministry (also known as "Faith Kids") on a full-time basis. The successful candidate will join our growing pastoral staff team based in Willetton, Perth. The aim of the Faith Kids ministry is to partner with parents to disciple kids to love God passionately and love people practically. The Kids Ministry Pastor will helm the Faith Kids leadership team, which includes children from the ages of 1.5 to 12 years old (Primary Year 6).

Key Responsibilities and Duties

- Lead the Faith Kids ministry in alignment with FCC's mission, vision and seasonal focus
- Provide pastoral leadership, coaching, care and discipleship to leaders
- Recruit, raise, train, develop and retain leaders and volunteers
- Spearhead and oversee the Faith Kids' Sunday programs across different campuses, Connect Group materials for Faith Kids annual kids camp, and other programs
- Collaborate with other ministries to holistically disciple kids both onsite and online
- Serve as a key liaison person for Faith Kids ministry to other ministries and external parties

- Aligns with the vision, mission and values of FCC as a home church
- Has a strong passion and experience in pastoring children and partnering with the parents
- Relevant experience in leading a local children ministry
- Proven ability to preach, teach, and develop leaders
- Demonstrated ability to relate well cross-culturally and intergenerationally

- Flexible and adaptable to changing priorities and duties
- Be a self-starter and team builder
- Thrives in a multi-generational and multi-department staff team environment
- Knowledge of Safe Church policies, guidelines and practices is an advantage
